Answer: When a whole is split into MORE equal parts, each part is SMALLER. $\frac{1}{3}$ means 3 parts (smaller pieces), $\frac{1}{2}$ means 2 parts (bigger pieces). So $\frac{1}{3} < \frac{1}{2}$.

Answer: Perimeter = $2(12+8) = 40$ m. Cost = $40 \times \$3 = \120 .

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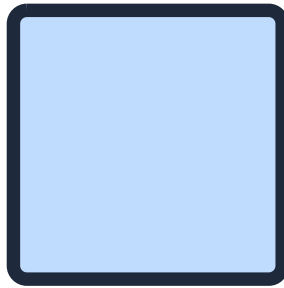
