Answer: Let w = width, $l = 2w + 3$. $2(w + 2w + 3) = 58 \Rightarrow 6w + 6 = 58 \Rightarrow w = 52/6 \Rightarrow 8.67$ cm, $l \Rightarrow 20.33$ cm.

Answer: Gross = $15.50 \times 25 = \$387.50$. Deductions = $0.22 \times 387.50 = \$85.25$. Net = $\$302.25$.



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
